## Hiland FFA Chapter Poster Contest 2023

### General Rules:

- Posters should be created using information gathered on the day of the tour
  - Must be student's original slogan and original artwork. No signatures on posters!
  - Posters should be traditional, hand-drawn and colored posters. Please use only 11 x 17 legal size cardstock paper for traditional posters.
  - Posters will be judged according to the criteria below.
  - Please print the name of the student, school, and teacher on the back "upper right corner" of each poster submitted.
  - Reproducibility of the poster will be a factor in the judges' decisions, so use good lettering, high contrast and bright colors!
  - Entries must be received by the Hiland FFA Chapter by Monday, October 23, 2023.
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### Themes:

- The poster and slogan must be original concepts and inspired by the farm tour.
  - Posters should be artistic, positive in approach, and focus on methods of conservation, sustainable or safe ag practices.
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### Judging:

Poster entries must be dropped off at the Hiland High School office by Monday, October 23. The FFA Chapter will judge the posters and the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be invited to the Holmes Soil and Water Conservation District annual meeting on Tuesday, November 14 at Harvest Ridge, Millersburg, to present their posters and receive an award. In addition, 1<sup>st</sup> prize = \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> = \$15, and 3<sup>rd</sup> = \$10. Submitted posters may be displayed at the annual SWCD meeting on November 15, the FFA Banquet, the Holmes County Fair, and on social media. The posters are judged on:

- Quality of design
- Creativity and originality of the artwork
- Creativity and originality of the slogan
- Appropriate theme using "positive" approach
- Reproducibility
